4-H programs are open to youth 9 -18 years of age. Are your children younger? No problem! Our Cloverbud Club is geared for children 5-8 years of age.

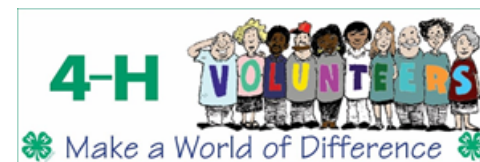
